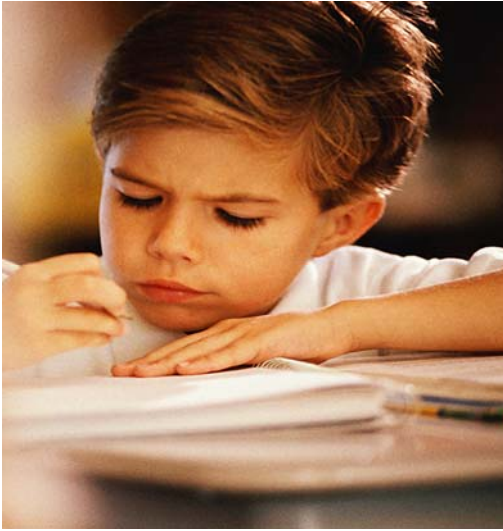


LEARN ABOUT YOUR CHILD'S READING ABILITIES!
